Immunizations

Childhood Immunizations

Ages 2mo. to 18 years
All the vaccinations that kids need to stay healthy.

Adult Immunizations

Adults need vaccinations to stay healthy, too!
Ask about available vaccines.

Travel Vaccines

For those traveling to other countries, extra vaccines may be necessary. Call for a consultation.

Visits for Moms, Babies & Families

Healthy Baby Home Visitation

During Pregnancy and through the first 2 years of baby's life, a nurse will visit and support to help assure healthy moms and healthy and developing babies.

Children's Special Health

Families of children with special healthcare needs can get support and help in accessing healthcare and services.

Maternal High Risk and Newborn Intensive Care

Extra support and possible financial help with high-risk pregnancies and premature babies.

Healthy Lifestyle Promotion

Wellness Program

Anyone interested in improving their health can work with a nurse to set and achieve goals for overall health and wellness. Can include such concerns as high blood pressure, weight loss, diabetes, etc.

Diabetes Education

For anyone concerned about Diabetes whether newly diabetic, pre-diabetic or more long-term, get support and education in managing the condition.

STD Prevention

STD Testing & Counseling

Confidential testing available for HIV, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and Syphilis for a low cost.

Nurses provide counseling on how to stay low-risk and disease free.
