Lodge & Cabins:

The Lodge/Cabin area can accommodate up to 140 people and has a lodge, kitchen and dining/recreation area with a large fireplace, shower house/restrooms and the warming hut off a large open air patio with grill. There are 12 cabins with single bunks per cabin (sleeps 10-12) play area, horseshoe pits, tetherball and a basketball standard.

The Yurt is about a mile away from the lodge/cabin area but is accessible by car or truck during summer months. It is a canvas structure on a deck and will sleep up to 8 people. It has an outhouse, fire ring, picnic table and cooking area with grill. There is no electricity or running water at the yurt but propane and some water are provided.
