Uinta County will accept the following: paint, household cleaners, cleaning chemicals, herbicides, and pesticides at the **City of Evanston's Yard Waste Site at 591 Union Road** from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.

1. YARD WASTE COLLECTION

OPEN every Monday from April 3 – October 30, 2023 (Except Holidays) 8:00 am – 6:00 pm
Residents may haul their YARD WASTE ONLY to 591 Union Road (Across from Union Tank Car)
The city will only collect yard waste at this event.

Compost and Wood Chips for Sale while supplies last. \$40.00 Compost, \$30.00 Wood Chips, both per cubic yard. One yard minimum. \$20.00 Curbside delivery, per load, in City limits.

2. LANDFILL PASS PROGRAM

The Landfill Pass Program allows City of Evanston residents to dispose of debris, not to exceed 1,000 pounds, at the Uinta County Landfill, at NO COST, **if your load is covered**. These passes do NOT include e-waste, tires, or refrigerators/freezers. Each residence that pays a City of Evanston garbage fee for your Utility, is allowed two landfill passes per year which may be picked up at the Public Works office at 33 Allegiance Circle, from 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. This is for Residential Use, NOT Commercial.

3. UINTA COUNTY HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

SATURDAY, MAY 20, 2023

Deliver your Hazardous Waste to two locations in Uinta County

The **City of Evanston's Yard Waste Site at 591 Union Road** from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm
or

Bridger Valley Transfer Station 4461 Hwy 412 North of I-80 **Carter Exit 10:00 am to 1:00 pm**

This is for Residential Use (Household quantities), NOT Commercial.

Items such as motor oil (gallon jugs), batteries, Fluorescent light bulbs may be delivered to the Landfill at no cost. E-waste (computers, TVs, VCRs), refrigerators/freezers, tires, construction waste, and MSW are accepted at the Landfill for a COST.

5. UINTA RECYCLING INC.

The Uinta Recycling Inc. (100 China Mary Road) is opened Monday thru Friday 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Uinta Recycling accepts steel, tin, aluminum, glass bottles & jars, newspapers, magazines (must remove plastic wrapping), junk mail (all paper products), corrugated cardboard, white office paper, and paperboard. They also accept E-waste (electronic devices such as glass screen TV's, VCR's & computers). TV's that will not fit in the totes at the Recycle Center can be taken to the Uinta County Landfill. There is a \$10.00 disposal fee for TV's, Monitors & Computers. They do NOT accept Plastic, Mirrors, Windows, Styrofoam, nor Pyrex.
